

WCCU Teacher Grant Program Awarding Guidelines

(To help the Teacher Grant Committee determine amount to award - Up to \$500 per Grant.)

The Teacher Grant Committee will rate each section individually and use those ratings to ASSIST in the consideration of a Grant award.

Points are given per project focus to help determine a consistent way to allocate funds based on the application.

Allocated amount to grant is based on total points. Maximum points available: 10, Minimum: 3.

6 - 10 Points = \$500 Grant, 3 - 5 Points = \$250 Grant

Project Focus	2 points	1 points	0 point
Educational Focus	Clear defined educational purpose.	Generalized educational purpose.	Little or no educational purpose.
Promotion of Skills/Excellence	Project specifically enhances academic skills and promotes educational excellence.	Project enhances academic skills and promotes educational excellence in a generalized way.	Project does not address academic skills or excellence in education.
Creativity/Innovation	Highly innovative/creative and is unique in nature.	Some innovation and creativity and is somewhat unique in nature.	No creativity or innovation.
Community Connection	Strong element of community involvement and/or supports student emotional, physical safety, and/or well-being within school & community.	Some levels of community involvement and/or support for student emotional, physical safety, and/or well-being within school & community.	No community involvement or elements of support for student emotional, physical safety, and/or well-being within school & community.
Goal Clarity and Attainability	Goal is clearly defined and specific. Applicant clearly states what they would like to accomplish with this project and provides evidence that the goal is attainable.	Goal is generally defined. Applicant states some of the possible benefits/accomplishments of the project and provides some evidence that the goal is attainable.	Goal is not defined. Applicant omits statements of what they would like to accomplish or does not show evidence that the goal is attainable.
